Patient Care Volunteers Provide

- **Companionship.** Visiting, listening, reading, laughing and crying
- **Respite Care.** Giving family members a few hours to rejuvenate
- **Chore Services:** Shopping, errands, light cleaning, lawn care, laundry, meal preparation
- **Pet Care:** Walking a dog, cleaning a cat box, feeding the fish
- **Correspondence:** Sending thank you cards, letters, making lists
- **Patient Care:** Help with ambulation, repositioning in chair / bed, transferring , toileting, dressing patient
